

# March 2016 MINUTES

The PHA meeting was held on March 10, 2016 at 7:00 pm, with 76 members in attendance and 15 new interested members. The meeting was held under the direction of the club President, Neil Evens, at Stone Creek Grill Steak and Pasta. This meeting was opened by saying the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

## REPORTS:

- A. Minutes were read by Austin Cooper for the February 2016 Meeting.
- B. Gerald Morgan gave a balance in checking account as of February 2016 — The BB&T account for the month of February 2016 had a starting balance of \$30,317.50 with total deposits of \$16,905.50 and \$6,893.42 in expenditures. This left an ending balance of \$40,012.08.  
The Bank of America checking account had a beginning balance of \$69,676.00 with no deposits or expenditures. Both accounts together total \$109,688.08.
- C. Plate Match – the March, 2016 match had 16 shooters and turned in \$160.00.
- D. Buffalo Shoot – N/A, will turn in for three months at the next meeting.
- E. Concealed Carry — \$168.00 turned in. Ernie Smith scheduled 4-5 classes.
- F. Shotgun Range - Barry Hedgecock turned in \$1,059.00 for February.
- G. .22 Match – N/A
- H. High power Match – N/A, next match will be in April 2016.
- I. Tactical Match – Had 90 shooters. Roger Reese turned in \$1,400.00 for February.
- J. Defensive Pistol – Brett Cummins – 10 shooters and turned in \$350.00.

All minutes were read and approved without any additions.

## OLD BUSINESS:

- 1-) Dick Jones reported on the new building with setting the location for the power pole.
- 2-) Ray Owens reported on the pistol bay drainage repairs. It was discovered that Bay 4 has an underground spring that will require more extensive work to provide drainage. Bay 5 was repaired as the original work bid. We are still within budget.
- 3-) The Young Marines will have their qualifying shoot on April 30, 2016 at 9:am. This will be on the same day as the Veterans Outing.  
Motion was made by Ray Owens with a second by Dick Jones. Approved by all attending.
- 4-) Mrs. Gallimore spoke to the PHA members to help support Eddie Gallimore with his run for North Carolina State Senate.
- 5-) Dave Rodgers spoke on the Snow Camp event, which five PHA members volunteered to help the Vet's during the day's activities.
- 6-) Neil suggested the use of a PA system to be used on the range for RO commands.  
Dick Jones donated two outdoor speakers. Neil donated an older CB for the power source.

- 7-) Dick Jones answered questions concerning the funds for the Benevolence Fund. He handed out a balance sheet to cover funds taken in and paid out. He also covered the two events at PHA and Blue Horizons and answered questions. It was decided to sponsor events at PHA and with \$2000.00 going to Blue Horizons. A motion was made Dick Jones with a second by Kenny Vanadore. Approved by 24 members and opposed by 7 members.
- 8-) An approval to add contact information for CCW class to the web site was agreed on.

### **New Business**

- 1-) PHA will have a fundraiser to be used for the purchase of two standard M4 or AR15 Rifles for use as the club rifles. One of the current heavy rifles will be used to raise funds. Tickets will be either \$5 or \$10.
- 2-) Neil Evens reviewed the minutes of the March, 2016 board meeting.
- A- New member walkthrough's will be limited to twice a month.
  - B- The gate will be locked during our matches to help reduce damages to our range.
  - C- A new logo will be designed for 2016 for T-shirts and hats.
- 3-) At the 200 yard range the 100-yard berm will be repaired using dirt taken from the berm Between pistol bays 3 and 4. The pistol bay berm will be replaced with a concrete wall. A motion was made by Dick Jones with a second by Kenny Van adore. Approved by all attending. Ray Owens will manage the project.
- 4-) New guidelines concerning membership renewals were reviewed. Membership runs from 1 Sep to 31 Aug. Dues must be paid prior to 15 Oct or a \$50 late fee attaches. If dues are not postmarked by 31 Dec of the current dues year, membership is dropped and rejoining requires going through the initial process again, including the initiation fee being paid.
- 5-) The PHA open house will be held on September 24, 2016.
- 6-) PHA will have a table at the Greensboro Gun Show in August, 2016.
- 7-) The club insurance with the NRA will be increased to cover the addition of new members.
- 8-) PHA will hold our veteran's event on April 30, 2016. Please sign up the Veteran's in your family.
- 9-) Concealed Carry classes will be scheduled thru Ernie Smith for range time. A fee of \$7 will Be charged for non-members. An payment conformation will need to be sent to Ernie For each class. Without the payment conformation, another class will not be scheduled. Checks with an Income / Expense report will need to be mailed to the club post office box.

A motion was made to close the meeting by all standing. All present approved.
