

April 2016 MINUTES

The PHA meeting was held on April 14, 2016 at 7:00 pm, with 87 members in attendance and 14 new interested members. The meeting was held under the direction of the club President, Neil Evens, at Skippers Seafood. This meeting was opened by saying the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

REPORTS:

- A. Minutes were read by Austin Cooper for the March 2016 Meeting.
- B. Gerald Morgan gave a balance in checking account as of March 2016 — The BB&T account for the month of March 2016 had a starting balance of \$40,012.08 with total deposits of \$5,417.00 and \$40,960.54 in expenditures. This left an ending balance of \$73,968.54.
The Bank of America checking account had a beginning balance of \$69,676.00 with no deposit. There was \$69,500.00 transferred to the BB&T account. The Bank of America account balance is \$276.00.
- C. Plate Match – the April, 2016 match had 13 shooters and turned in \$125.00.
- D. Buffalo Shoot – \$540.00 for three months.
- E. Concealed Carry — N/A
- F. Shotgun Range - Barry Hedgecock turned in \$1,054.00 for March.
- G. .22 Match – There were 21 shooters in March turned in \$105.00. 9 shooters in April turned in \$45.00.
- H. High power Match – N/A, next match will be in April 2016.
- I. Tactical Match – Canceled in March due to rain.
- J. Defensive Pistol – Brett Cummins – 35 shooters and turned in \$300.00.

All minutes were read and approved without any additions.

OLD BUSINESS:

- 1-) PHA will have a fundraiser to be used for the purchase of two standard M4 or AR15 Rifles for use as the club rifles. One of the current heavy rifles will be used to raise funds. Tickets will be either \$5 or \$10.
- 2-) Neil Evens reviewed the minutes of the March, 2016 board meeting.
 - A- New member walkthrough's will be limited to twice a month.
 - B- The gate will be locked during our matches to help reduce damages to our range.
 - C- A new logo will be designed for 2016 for T-shirts and hats.
- 3-) At the 200 yard range the 100-yard berm will be repaired using dirt taken from the berm Between pistol bays 3 and 4. The pistol bay berm will be replaced with a concrete wall. A motion was made by Dick Jones with a second by Kenny Van adore. Approved by all attending. Ray Owens will manage the project.

- 4-) New guidelines concerning membership renewals were reviewed. Membership runs from 1 Sep to 31 Aug., Dues must be paid prior to 15 Oct or a \$50 late fee attaches. If dues are not postmarked by 31 Dec of the current dues year, membership is dropped and rejoining requires going through the initial process again, including the initiation fee being paid.
- 5-) The PHA open house will be held on September 24, 2016.
- 6-) PHA will have a table at the Greensboro Gun Show in August 2016.
- 7-) The club insurance with the NRA will be increased to cover the addition of new members.
- 8-) PHA will hold our veteran's event on April 30, 2016. Please sign up the Veteran's in your family.
- 9-) Concealed Carry classes will be scheduled thru Ernie Smith for range time. A fee of \$7 will Be charged for non-members. A payment conformation will need to be sent to Ernie For each class. Without the payment conformation, another class will not be scheduled. Checks with an Income / Expense report will need to be mailed to the club post office box.

New Business

- 1-) Our new building is up and ready to occupy.
- 2-) The drains in bays 3 and 4 are finished and bay 4 is under way.
- 3-) A box for returned temp badges has been installed on the outside of the building at the .22 range.
- 4-) The berms at pistol bays 2, 3 and 4 will be replace with poured concrete walls. We are waiting for cost estimates from the contractor. The bays will be closed for approximately one week. Motion to proceed by Brent Cummings and a second by Dick Jones.
- 5-) All members present agreed to have future meetings at Skipper's Seafood on Hwy. 64.
- 6-) There will be a berm added at twenty-five yards on the 200 yard range.
- 7-) This year's PHA shirt logo will be decide on at the next board meeting.
- 8-) A need for a welder at the range is being researched and we should have one shortly
