

June 2016 MINUTES

The PHA meeting was held on June 09, 2016 at 7:00 pm, with 54 members in attendance and 5 new interested members. The meeting was held under the direction of the club President, Neil Evens, at Skippers Seafood. This meeting was opened by saying the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

REPORTS:

- A. Minutes were read by Austin Cooper for the May 2016 Meeting.
- B. Gerald Morgan gave a balance in checking account as of May 2016 — The BB&T account for the month of May 2016 had a starting balance of \$58,410.89 with total deposits of \$4,264.00 and \$13,591.42 in expenditures. This left an ending balance of \$49,083.47.
The Bank of America checking account had a beginning balance of \$276.00 with no deposit. The Bank of America account balance is \$276.00. The total for both accounts is \$49,359.47
- C. Plate Match – the June, 2016 match had 24 shooters and turned in \$165.00.
- D. Buffalo Shoot – N/A
- E. Concealed Carry — N/A
- F. Shotgun Range - Barry Hedgecock turned in \$858.00 for May.
- G. .22 Match – There were 13 shooters in May turned in \$65.00.
- H. High power Match – There were 8 shooters and turned in \$90.00
- I. Tactical Match – Canceled in May due to rain.
- J. Defensive Pistol – Brett Cummins – 20 shooters and turned in \$190.00.

All minutes were read and approved without any additions.

OLD BUSINESS:

- 1-) The young Marines had 13 precipitants for their qualifying day. All did well and hope to return next year.
- 2-) David Motsinger spoke on the Veterans Event held April, 2016. There were 34 vets' And 32 volunteers that showed up. Everyone attending had a great day.
- 3-) The subject of term limits for elected officers was revisited. Terms will remain on an annual basis with elections being held in September as in the past. It was also mentioned the need for more volunteers to help with matches and range maintenance.
- 4-) The berms at pistol bays 3 and 4 will be replaced with concrete walls. The board is waiting for a quote to finalize the project. The dirt from the berm will be used to repair areas of the range.
- 5-) The Benevalce Committee will need to approve in advance any donations or fund matching. There has been a cap of \$2,000.00 for donations.

- 6-) Any instructors using the range for training will need to register with the club before starting any activities. All instructors' need to be PHA members. Instructors will need to contact Erine Smith to schedule the range time.
- 7-) Club AR's – One will be sold and one will stay with the club. A standard M2 style rifle Will be purchased for use at the range matches.
- 8-) The shirts have been approved and will be ordered. Some samples will be available at the next meeting to help with preorders.
- 9-) Our tables and chairs will be in the new building by end of May.
- 10-) The gates will need to remain locked during the matches. Match directors will have a third lock that will have a combination just for that day that participates can use to leave early.

New Business

- 1-) The July meeting will be held on the third Thursday – 07/21/2016 at Skippers Seafood Restaurant. Motion made by Brett Cummings, 2nd by Kenny Vanadore.
- 2-) The Davidson County Young Marines announced that they will have a Flag Retirement Ceremony at Forest Hill Memorial Park entrance on 18, June, 2016. If you have an old Flag, please bring it by and retire it with dignity.
- 3-) Our nominating committee is still adding names for the 2016 elections. Renewals, ballots Range rules for the year 2016 – 2017 will go out in July.
- 4-) The shirts and hats for our open house will be ordered.
- 5-) PHA will have a table at the Greensboro Gun Show on August 27 – 28, 2016. Volunteers are needed.
- 6-) The PHA open house will be on September 24, 2016. There will be a clean up day the weekend before.
- 7-) We are waiting for final quotes so we can begin the berm repairs and wall construction.
- 8-) The club rifles will remain with the club and will be modified to be more comfortable for our guest to use.
- 9-) It was agreed to not use air rifles on the .22 range. This is due to the modern air rifles having more power and using pellets made from material other than lead.
- 10-) The PHA Range owners meeting will be held at Skippers Seafood Restaurant on August 16, 2016.
- 11-) We are still looking for a welder for the range repair.
- 12-) All instructors who are using the PHA range for training must register with PHA.
- 13-) The 200 yard range – PHA has tabled for the decision on purchasing steel targets for this part of the range. Anyone who wishes to use their own steel targets will need to have the Range Officer inspect and sign off on the targets before being used. A motion was made by Roger Reese with a second by Brett Cummings. Approved by all.
