

July 2016 MINUTES

The PHA meeting was held on July 21, 2016 at 7:00 pm, with 63 members in attendance and 10 new interested members. The meeting was held under the direction of the club President, Neil Evens, at Skippers Seafood. This meeting was opened by saying the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

REPORTS:

- A. Minutes were read by Austin Cooper for the June 2016 Meeting.
- B. Gerald Morgan gave a balance in checking account as of June 2016 — The BB&T account for the month of June 2016 had a starting balance of \$49,083.47 with total deposits of \$9,042.73 and \$2,440.72 in expenditures. This left an ending balance of \$55,685.48.
The Bank of America checking account had a beginning balance of \$276.00 with no deposit. The Bank of America account balance is \$276.00. The total for both accounts is \$55,961.48.
- C. Plate Match – the June, 2016 match had 9 shooters and turned in \$140.00.
- D. Buffalo Shoot – N/A
- E. Concealed Carry — \$7.00
- F. Shotgun Range - Barry Hedgecock turned in \$1,459.00 for June.
- G. .22 Match – For 6/11/2016 – 17 Shooters, \$85.00. For 7/9/2016 – 19 shooters, \$95.00.
- H. High power Match – There were 12 shooters and turned in \$142.50
- I. Tactical Match – For 6/18/2016 – 50 shooters, \$815.00.
For 7/16/2016 – 47 shooters, \$680.00

All minutes were read and approved without any additions.

OLD BUSINESS:

- 1-) The July meeting will be held on the third Thursday – 07/21/2016 at Skippers Seafood Restaurant. Motion made by Brett Cummings, 2nd by Kenny Vanadore.
- 2-) The Davidson County Young Marines announced that they will have a Flag Retirement Ceremony at Forest Hill Memorial Park entrance on 18, June, 2016. If you have an old Flag, please bring it by and retire it with dignity.
- 3-) Our nominating committee is still adding names for the 2016 elections. Renewals, ballots Range rules for the year 2016 – 2017 will go out in July.
- 4-) The shirts and hats for our open house will be ordered.
- 5-) PHA will have a table at the Greensboro Gun Show on August 27 – 28, 2016. Volunteers are needed.
- 6-) The PHA open house will be on September 24, 2016. There will be a cleanup day the

weekend before.

- 7-) We are waiting for final quotes so we can begin the berm repairs and wall construction.
- 8-) The club rifles will remain with the club and will be modified to be more comfortable for our guest to use.
- 9-) It was agreed to not use air rifles on the .22 range. This is due to the modern air rifles having more power and using pellets made from material other than lead.
- 10-) The PHA Range owners meeting will be held at Skippers Seafood Restaurant on August 16, 2016.
- 11-) We are still looking for a welder for the range repair.
- 12-) All instructors who are using the PHA range for training must register with PHA.
- 13-) The 200 yard range – PHA has tabled for the decision on purchasing steel targets for this part of the range. Anyone who wishes to use their own steel targets will need to have the Range Officer inspect and sign off on the targets before being used.

New Business

- 1-) Ray Owens presented a request to donate \$100.00 to the Long Beards National Wild Turkey Federation for Jake day. The Benevolence committee approved this. The hat was passed and took in \$177.00. A motion was made by Neil Evans and a 2nd by Kenny Vanadore. All attending approved.
- 2-) Neil Evans introduced the nominees for the 2016 – 2017 club officer elections.
- 3-) Cody Reed asked for board approval to start an archery range on the club property. This will be decided on at the next board meeting.
- 4-) The shirts and hats for our open house have been ordered and should be delivered by the last week of August.
- 5-) PHA will have a table at the Greensboro Gun Show on August 27 – 28, 2016. Volunteers are needed.
- 6-) The PHA open house will be on September 24, 2016. There will be a clean up day the weekend before.
- 7-) Fred Sink passed around a flyer for the Friends of the NRA dinner at Tangle Wood on 8/11/2016.
- 8-) The search for a welder is on hold for now. Roger Reese will continue to use his equipment.
- 9-) A motion was made by David McDonald to have the new officers installed at the September meeting. Ballots should be in by August 31, 2016.
- 10-) The berm rebuild project is still in motion and will use the pre-fabricated concrete blocks. Our cost will be approximately \$6,000.00 to \$8,000.00 per berm wall.
- 11-) The 200 yard range – Steel gongs have been ordered for a cost of \$129.00 each. Also One target will be ordered from Raeford for a cost of \$170.00. No armor piercing or steel core rounds are to be used on the steel targets.
- 12-) Our building is in the process of having the permit situation resolved.

13-) One of the club members inquired about renting the shotgun range for a Saturday event.

All involved are in agreement for this to be held.

14-) Roger Reese announced that the Tactical T – shirts are now available.

A motion was made to close the meeting by all standing. All present approved.
