

January 2017 MINUTES

PHA held its monthly meeting on January 12, 2017 at 7:00 pm, with 72 members in attendance and 13 new interested members. The meeting was held under the direction of the club President, Neil Evens, at Skippers Seafood.

This meeting was opened by saying the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

REPORTS:

- A. Minutes were read by Austin Cooper for the November 2016 Meeting.
- B. Gerald Morgan gave a balance in checking account as of November 2016 — The BB&T account for the month of November 2016 had a starting balance of \$135,624.46 with total deposits of \$13,063.20 and \$8,399.69 in expenditures. This left an ending balance of \$140,287.97.
The BB&T account for the month of December 2016 had a starting balance of \$140,287.97 with total deposits of \$4,656.50 with \$1,750.46 in expenditures. This left an ending balance of \$143,194.01.
- C. Plate Match – the December, 2016 match had 11 shooters and turned in \$115.00.
January match called due to weather.
- D. Buffalo Shoot – N/A.
- E. Concealed Carry — \$49.00
- F. Shotgun Range – For the months of November and December 2016 \$1,440.00 was turned in. The total for 2016 was \$10,581.00 with a net of \$4,650.00.
- G. .22 Match – The November match had 15 shooter's and turned in \$80.00. December N/A.
- H. High power Match – N/A. Next match in April.
- I. Tactical Match – For November, 2016 – 58 shooters, \$1,450.00. For the year of 2016 had a net of \$8,760.00
- J. Defensive Pistol – N/A.

All minutes were read and a motion to accept was made by Cody Reed with a second by Ray Owens. Approved by all attending.

OLD BUSINESS:

- 1-) The Building – We need to add fire extinguishers at each door. Two extra turnouts need to be added in the turns that will be twenty feet wide and graveled. The county has all of the necessary paper work and is waiting on the Fire Marshall approval.
- 2-) Fred Sink presented the details concerning the berm project. Three berms would be removed and five walls 100 feet in length and one wall 130 feet in length will be added. The dirt from the berms will be used to affect repairs at different areas of the range. The schedule to begin work will be in December 2016. Drains at the 50 – 100 yard range will be added. Estimated cost is \$50,000.00. A motion to proceed with this project was made by Gerald Morgan with a second by David Speight. An amendment to add a 20

foot x 6 foot wall at the end of the 50 – 100 yard range at the drive way was made by Roger Reese. Neil Evans added grading and a short wall around the side of the building be done during this time. This will raise the estimated cost to \$60,000.00. A motion to accept the amendment was made by Kenny Vanadore and second by David Speight. Accepted by all attending.

- 3-) There will be changes to our renewal and annual voting process. All renewal's and ballots Will be mailed out June 30th of the year.
- 4-) PHA will have a table at the Greensboro Gun Show in August.
- 5-) The Archery Range – The old road will be graded and Cody Reed will start the target layout. In addition, a practice range will be added.
- 6-) Our NRA insurance will increase due to the addition of new members. We will have a firm dollar amount when we renew in March.
- 7-) Volunteers are needed to apply a dust abatement to our entrance road. The sprayer we have should be able to handle the job.

New Business

- 1-) The Building – Ray Owens reported that the permits were approved without any Penalties. We need gravel placed on the turnouts for the Fire Marshall to sign off.
- 2-) Berms – We are waiting for the weather to break to allow the contractor's to proceed.
- 3-) Cody Reed had a sample target that will be used on the archery range. The final size Will be 4 foot x 4 foot x 12 inches of layered foam. We will start with two targets at a cost of \$150.00 each. A motion was made by David Montsinger to allot \$500.00 for the purchase of two targets and the construction of a foot bridge over the creek area. There was a second by Donnie Small, approved by all attending.
- 4-) Our website will be updated with the contact information of PHA officers and Board members.
- 5-) Membership renewals – The board agreed to have firm end dates concerning our annual membership renewals. The nominating committee will have a final list by May 30th. The month of June will be used to print ballots, forms and the newsletter. The mailing will be the last week of June. All dues need to be paid by August 31, 2017. Any dues paid after September 20, 2017 will have a penalty assessed. The gate codes will be changed on September 20, 2017.
- 6-) The benevolence fund has been closed with funds dispersed to The Young Marines and The Junior Order Children's Home.
- 7-) David Montsinger volunteered to order the steel for the new pistol bays.

A motion was made to close the meeting by all standing. All present approved.
