

February 2017 MINUTES

PHA held its monthly meeting on February 09, 2017 at 7:00 pm, with 68 members in attendance and 14 new interested members. The meeting was held under the direction of the club President, Neil Evens, at Skippers Seafood.

This meeting was opened by saying the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

REPORTS:

- A. Minutes were read by Austin Cooper for the January 2017 Meeting.
- B. Gerald Morgan gave a balance in checking account as of January 2017 — The BB&T account for the month of January 2017 had a starting balance of \$143,194.01 with total deposits of \$10,730.95 and \$8,108.66 in expenditures. This left an ending balance of \$145,691.30.
- C. Plate Match – N/A – No walls.
- D. Buffalo Shoot – Turned in \$500.00 for the months of December 2016, January 2017.
- E. Concealed Carry — N/A
- F. Shotgun Range – Turned in \$834.00 for January.
- G. .22 Match – N/A
- H. High power Match – N/A. Next match in April.
- I. Tactical Match – Turned in \$745.00 – 50 shooters.
- J. Defensive Pistol – Turned in \$0.00 after expenses – 35 shooters.

All minutes were read with Roger Reese making a motion to accept and a second by Dick Jones. Approved by all attending.

OLD BUSINESS:

- 1-) The Building – Ray Owens reported that the permits were approved without any Penalties. We need gravel placed on the turnouts for the Fire Marshall to sign off.
- 2-) Berms – We are waiting for the weather to break to allow the contractor's to proceed.
- 3-) Cody Reed had a sample target that will be used on the archery range. The final size Will be 4 foot x 4 foot x 12 inches of layered foam. We will start with two targets at a cost of \$150.00 each. A motion was made by David Montsinger to allot \$600.00 for the purchase of two targets and the construction of a foot bridge over the creek area. There was a second by Donnie Small, approved by all attending.
- 4-) Our website will be updated with the contact information of PHA officers and Board members.
- 5-) Membership renewals – The board agreed to have firm end dates concerning our annual membership renewals. The nominating committee will have a final list by May 30th. The month of June will be used to print ballots, forms and the newsletter. The mailing will be the last week of June. All dues need to be paid by August 31, 2017. Any dues paid after September 20, 2017 will have a penalty assessed. The gate

codes will be changed on September 20, 2017.

- 6-) The benevolence fund has been closed with funds dispersed to The Young Marines and The Junior Order Children's Home.
- 7-) David Montsinger volunteered to order the steel for the new pistol bays.

New Business

- 1-) The Building – We are required to have fire alarm pulls at each door which need an engineer drawing before installation with final approval by the county inspector. After the installation of the alarm system our local fire marshal will have the final walk- thru and this should bring closure to the project. The gravel turnouts have been finished.
- 2-) Berms – Two of the walls are completed and three walls are under way. The final grading is under way, all should be completed by the end of February.
- 3-) The 2017 – 2018 nominating committee positions were filled. Chair is Roger Reese with Cody Reed and Phil Harris filling out the committee. All nominations need to be in by April 30, 2017 with ballots ready to be mailed out 06/01/2017.
- 4-) The Trauma kits at the .22 range and the block building by the pistol bays are accessible by all members. They should use the gate code to enter the buildings.
- 5-) We had some reports that the tactical bay props were being used for target stands. **All props and barrels are not to be used for target placement.** Targets should be on proper stands and placed so all rounds will impact the berm. Members should bring their own stands and targets. When leaving the range use the dumpster at the pistol bays for all trash and used targets.
- 6-) Our first practice archery target has been built and ready to use. Cody Reed, Harold Fullam, Dennis Swicegood and David Montsinger did a great job with this project. In the future there will be 3-D targets in storage and used only for the matches.
- 7-) Contact information for the match director's needs to be updated on our website. Barry Hedgecock suggested that pictures of the match director's be added.

A motion was made to close the meeting by all standing. All present approved.
