

March 2017 MINUTES

PHA held its monthly meeting on March 09, 2017 at 7:00 pm, with 76 members in attendance and 12 new interested members. The meeting was held under the direction of the club President, Neil Evens, at Skippers Seafood.

This meeting was opened by saying the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

REPORTS:

- A. Minutes were read by Austin Cooper for the February 2017 Meeting.
- B. Gerald Morgan gave a balance in checking account as of February 2017 — The BB&T account for the month of February 2017 had a starting balance of \$145,691.30 with total deposits of \$3,917.00 and \$63,459.03 in expenditures with the largest expense being for the Pistol Bay wall project. This left an ending balance of \$86,149.27. A motion to accept the financial report was made by Cody Reed with a second by Kenny Vanadore. Accepted by all attending.
- C. Plate Match – 6 shooters and turned in \$70.00.
- D. Buffalo Shoot – 8 shooters and turned in \$70.00 for December 18, 2016. There were 16 shooters and turned in \$150.00 for February 19, 2017.
- E. Concealed Carry — N/A
- F. Shotgun Range – Turned in \$1,155.00 for February.
- G. .22 Match – 20 shooters and turned in \$100.00.
- H. High power Match – Had 11 shooters for the vintage rifle course and turned in \$110.00.
- I. Tactical Match – Had 69 shooters and turned in \$1,110.00.
- J. Defensive Pistol – had 20 shooters and turned in \$200.00.

All minutes were read with Roger Reese making a motion to accept and a second by Dick Jones. Approved by all attending.

OLD BUSINESS:

- 1-) The Building – We are required to have fire alarm pulls at each door which need an engineer drawing before installation with final approval by the county inspector. After the instillation of the alarm system our local fire marshal will have the final walk- thru and this should bring closure to the project. The gravel turnouts have been finished.
- 2-) Berms – Two of the walls are completed and three walls are under way. The final grading is under way, all should be completed by the end of February.
- 3-) The 2017 – 2018 nominating committee positions were filled. Chair is Roger Reese with Cody Reed and Phil Harris filling out the committee. All nominations need to be in by April 30, 2017 with ballots ready to be mailed out 06/01/2017.
- 4-) The Trauma kit at the .22 range and the block building by the pistol bays are accessible by all members. They should use the gate code to enter the buildings.

Amendment – The .22 range does not have a trauma kit. This kit is located at the Shotgun range is not accessible by all members. There is a kit at the block building which

can be accessed with the gate code.

- 5-) We had some reports that the tactical bay props were being used for target stands. **All props and barrels are not to be used for target placement.** Targets should be on proper stands and placed so all rounds will impact the berm. Members should bring their own stands and targets. When leaving the range use the dumpster at the pistol bays for all trash and used targets.
- 6-) Our first practice archery target has been built and ready to use. Cody Reed, Harold Fullam, Dennis Swicegood and David Montsinger did a great job with this project. In the future there will be 3-D targets in storage and used only for the matches.
- 7-) Contact information for the match director's needs to be updated on our website. Barry Hedgecock suggested that pictures of the match director's be added.

New Business

- 1-) The Building – The engineer drawing for the fire alarm system has been turned to the County offices. We still need the alarm's installed before the final sign off by the Fire Marshall.
- 2-) Berms – Our Pistol Bay walls are complete with one exception. Bay one (next to the 50-100 yard range) is closed until the end wall/berm can be closed off. This bay will be for paper targets only.
- 3-) Contact information for the matches has been updated on our web site. If there is a cancelation of a match, please contact Russ in advance so a notice can be posted. Try to give three days' notice if possible.
- 4-) Our first archery shoot is scheduled for the middle to late April. This will be a 3-D shoot.
- 5-) The 2017 – 2018 nominating committee positions were filled. Chair is Roger Reese with Cody Reed and Phil Harris filling out the committee. **All nominations need to be in by April 30, 2017 with ballots, newsletter and renewal forms to be mailed out 06/01/2017.** Please include a short bio.
- 6-) The board is contacting suppliers for new steel targets for the pistol bays. In addition, we need four new carport/shelters for pistol and tactical bays. Quotes to come.
- 6-) Our next work day will be April 22, 2017 – Saturday from 9:00am until noon.
- 7-) Use of Shotguns in the pistol bays will be limited to 7 1/2 shot or smaller and use paper targets only. Please pick up your empty shells.
- 8-) 200 yard range - The circular drive at the 200 yard range needs to be reworked for better access. This would entail removing the current drives and grading the area for better parking and drainage. This will be a project for next fall.
- 9-) Wooden picnic tables are needed for the new pistol bays. These will have a cost of \$100.00 each with four needed. A motion was made by Fred Sink to make the purchase with a second by Cody Reed, approved by all attending members.
- 10-) A suggestion was made to add another Port-A-Jon at the .22 range. A motion was made Roger Reese with a second by Fred Sink, Approved by all attending.

A motion was made to close the meeting by all standing. All present approved.
