

September 2017 MINUTES

PHA held its monthly meeting on September 14, 2017 at 7:00 pm, with 69 members in attendance and 8 new interested members. The meeting was held under the direction of the club President, Neil Evens, at Skippers Seafood.

REPORTS:

- A. Austin Cooper read the minutes with Kenny Vanadore making a motion to accept and a second by Roger Reese. Approved by all attending.
- B. Gerald Morgan gave a balance in checking account as of September 2017 — The BB&T account for the month had a starting balance of \$107,099.00 with total deposits of \$43,647.82. We had \$5,644.30 in expenditures. This left an ending balance of \$145,102.52. A motion to accept the financial report was made by Nancy Muller with a second by Kenny Vanadore. - 3-) John Sutter has finalized the acquisition of a new web host with Godaddy and is in the process of transferring the web page from the old server. The new web host has been registered in PHA's name.
