

May 2016 MINUTES

The PHA meeting was held on May 12, 2016 at 7:00 pm, with 59 members in attendance and 7 new interested members. The meeting was held under the direction of the club President, Neil Evens, at Skippers Seafood. This meeting was opened by saying the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

REPORTS:

- A. Minutes were read by Austin Cooper for the April 2016 Meeting.
- B. Gerald Morgan gave a balance in checking account as of April 2016 — The BB&T account for the month of April 2016 had a starting balance of \$73,968.54 with total deposits of \$6,757.00 and \$22,314.65 in expenditures. This left an ending balance of \$58,410.89.
The Bank of America checking account had a beginning balance of \$276.00 with a balance of \$276.00.
- C. Plate Match – the May, 2016 match had 27 shooters and turned in \$130.00 after expenses.
- D. Buffalo Shoot – N/A
- E. Concealed Carry — N/A
- F. Shotgun Range - Barry Hedgecock turned in \$833.00 for April.
- G. .22 Match – N/A – rain.
- H. High power Match – N/A, next match will be in April 2016.
- I. Tactical Match – 70 shooters and turned in \$1,145.00.
- J. Defensive Pistol – Brett Cummins – 15 shooters and turned in \$125.00.

All minutes were read and approved without any additions.

OLD BUSINESS:

- 1-) Our new building is up and ready to occupy.
- 2-) The drains in bays 3 and 4 are finished and bay 4 is under way.
- 3-) A box for returned temp badges has been installed on the outside of the building at the .22 range.
- 4-) The berms at pistol bays 2, 3 and 4 will be replaced with poured concrete walls. We are waiting for cost estimates from the contractor. The bays will be closed for approximately one week. Motion to proceed by Brent Cummings and a second by Dick Jones.
- 5-) All members present agreed to have future meetings at Skipper's Seafood on Hwy. 64.
- 6-) There will be a berm added at twenty-five yards on the 200 yard range.
- 7-) This year's PHA shirt logo will be decided on at the next board meeting.
- 8-) A need for a welder at the range is being researched and we should have one shortly.

New Business

- 1-) The young Marines had 13 precapcpts for their qualifying day. All did well and hope to return next year.
- 2-) David Motsinger spoke on the Veterans Event held April, 2016. There were 34 vets' And 32 voleenters that showed up. Everyone attending had a great day.
- 3-) The subject of term limits for elected officers was revisited. Terms will remain on a annual bases with elections being held in September as in the past. It was also mentioned the need for more volunteers to help with matches and range maintenance.
- 4-) The berms at pistol bays 3 and 4 will be replaced with concrete walls. The board is waiting for a quote to finalize the project. The dirt from the berm will be used to repair areas of the range.
- 5-) The Benevalce Committee will need to approve in advance any donations or fund matching. There has been a cap of \$2,000.00 for donations.
- 6-) Any instructors using the range for training will need to register with the club before starting any activites. All instructor's need to be PHA members. Instructor's will need to contact Erine Smith to schedule the range time.
- 7-) Club AR's – One will be sold and one will stay with the club. A standard M2 style rifle Will be purchased for use at the range matches.
- 8-) The shirts have been approved and will be ordered. Some samples will be available at the next meeting to help with preorders.
- 9-) Our tables and chairs will be in the new building by end of May.
- 10-) The gates will need to remain locked during the matches. Match directors will have a third lock that will have a combination just for that day that participates can use to leave early.
