

August 2018 MINUTES

PHA held its monthly meeting on August 09, 2018 at 7:00 pm, with 75 members in attendance and 8 new interested members. The meeting was held under the direction of the club President, Neil Evans, at Skippers Seafood.

This meeting was opened by saying the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag and thanking our Lord with a short prayer.

New Business

- 1-) PHA will have a someone new to update our website by the end of August 2018.
- 2-) Open House will be on September 22, 2018.
- 3-) All ballots should be in by August 31, 2018.
- 4-) Cameras at the pistol bays – Two have been installed and one more to be installed.

- 7-) The 17 acres adjacent to PHA will be evaluated by an outside agent, possibly the Forest Service. If the evaluation is positive PHA will need to agree on a dollar amount before approaching the current land owner.

- 9-) The Archery range is open, Bokie will place the last few targets soon. Thank You Bokie.
- 10) Our work day this year will be on September 15, 2018

- 12) Roofs – The BOD have two estimates with the lowest bid at \$6,350.00 for the 100 yard and 200 yard ranges to replace the old metal and sheeting. Donnie Small made a motion to accept with a second by Scott Dowd, approved by all attending.
- 13) PHA will have a table at the Greensboro Gun Show the weekend of August 25-26, 2018.
- 14) Fred Sink announced a Friends of NRA event on September 11, 2018 at the Elks Lodge in Forsyth County. Tickets and address can be purchased at the Gun Store on Old Winston Rd.
- 15) Roger Reese made a request to pass the hat to have a grounds service for Ron Gerren. He also requested to have PHA match funds. We had \$725.00 taking in at the meeting with a match from the club. A motion was made by Roger Reese with a second by Ernie Smith, approved by all attending.
