NEW BUSINESS

1. Ray introduced Eddie Gallimore, State Senator for NC.
2. Ray reviewed the decisions made about the purchase of the new rabbit thrower and the disposition of the old thrower.
3. Dick Jones suggested digging a trench between the berms and targets on the 100 and 200 yard ranges.
4. Neil Evans reported that the wire at the 100 and 200 yard ranges is completely down.
5. Ray reported that the club bylaws dated September 2015 talked about and reviewed but was never formally voted on by the Board of Directors. A revision to the bylaws is currently being done by a committee. And we expect to have them soon.

8. Robert "Bokie" Sherk informed us that Rob Fritts has been assigned as Chairman of the Long Term Planning Committee. If you would like to be on that committee, please contact Rob Fritts.
9. Ray Owens talked about the shooting fees for the 5-stand Shot gun Range. Clays for the 5-stand now cost \$11.56 +tax +delivery. Recently, rabbit thrower was replaced, the 5-stand itself was remodeled, and now thrower #7 is having severe problems and will have to be replaced at a cost of \$1295. +tax +delivery. The Board voted to raise the fees to \$6 for non-members, \$5 for

members, and \$3 for day-of-shoot for Range Officer and crew.

Neil Evans made a motion to raise the fees to \$6 for non-members, \$5 for members, and \$3 for day-of-shoot for Range Officer and crew. Seconded. Discussion.

Donnie Small, Shotgun Match Director, made a motion to table the previous motion until the next general meeting so that he can meet with the Board at their next Board meeting. Seconded.
