New Business

- 2-) Gerald Morgan made inquires to hire an accountant to handle the club's finances. He was referred to one firm which gave a quote of \$10,000.00 + annually to provide a audit and maintain the records. Gerald is still interviewing other accountants.
- 3-) The Board of Director's approved to have rain gutters installed at the .22 range and the 100 yard range. Fascias boards need to be added also.
- 4-) Tarps were approved to provide a sun block at the .22 range benches where the bench rest match is held. These will be designed so they can be raised or lowered.
- 5-) Ruth McDonald reported about the Junior Order Children's Home for the New Year.
- 6) The board of director's approved the use of instructor's to have classes in the building. They will need to request access from a board member before the class date.
- 7) Shotgun Range committee needs to meet and workout a schedule as to who will be the RO's on the weekends.
